Students improve their analytical, problem-solving and STEM-related competencies; while building their social, presentation and team-building skills.

ACT-SO is an academic and talent-based program for African-American high school youth in the areas of STEM, Entrepreneurship, Humanities, Performing Arts and Visual Arts. Students receive mentoring to prepare for the March competition where they compete for medals and cash prizes in 32 categories.
